On 23rd June 2019 the NYHO will be hosting a day with the Austrian Harpist & Composer Monika Stadler. Monika began studying the harp at the age of thirteen at the Bruckner-Conservatory in Linz, Austria and then at the University of Music & Performing Arts in Vienna under Professor Adelheid Blovsky-Miller. During her studies she played with the Vienna Symphony Orchestra. In 1990 she finished her studies at the University with the highest honours and received a scholarship to study jazz harp in 1991/92 Deborah Henson-Conant, jazz bassist David Clark (Berklee College of Music, Boston) and free improvisational music with David Darling in the USA.
